

boundaries, and cooperate with investigators to the fullest extent possible within its charge to preserve all species of flora and fauna and geological materials and formations in a natural state, insofar as possible.

- (1) Resource manipulation and specimen collection is strictly limited in scope and nature to that which is outlined in the mutually agreed upon research proposal. Any alteration will require an amendment to the proposal and this permit.
- (2) The Permittee is required to comply with all rules and regulations outlined in Title 36, Code of Federal Regulations as well as other special regulations established by the Superintendent.
- (3) All equipment and facilities loaned to the Permittee will be used in a professional manner and will be returned in the same or better condition than when they were originally loaned, notwithstanding normal wear and tear.
- (4) Permittees or associates who operate U.S. Government motor vehicles are required to have in their possession a valid State drivers license.
- (5) All appropriate permits will be on file with park staff. This includes any additional NPS Permits, State permits, and U.S. Fish and Wildlife Service permits.
- (6) The Permittee is required to abide by all special requirements stipulated in the above mentioned permits. Those requirements are considered an extension of this list.
- (7) All unsafe conditions identified in the park will be brought to the attention of the Superintendent or Chief of Resources Management.
- (8) Any accidents involving the Permittee or his/her associates that occur on park lands or in NPS equipment will be brought to the attention of the Superintendent or Chief of Resources Management immediately.
- (9) Permittees are required to have a copy of the Research Permit and all other associated permits in their possession when working in the field.
- (10) A copy of all scientific or other publications resulting entirely or in part from research activities resulting from the issuance of this permit will be furnished to the Superintendent or Chief of Resources Management as soon as completed.
- (11) Failure to abide by these conditions may result in revocation of this permit and suspension of the project.
