

The following script will be read prior to survey administration:

Today you'll be participating in a survey. This is part of a project by North Carolina State University, the North Carolina Museum of Natural Sciences, and the North Carolina Wildlife Resources Commission is conducting on how kids think about animals. If you returned a signed form stating that you and/or your parents decline to participate, you will not participate in this survey and will not be penalized.

When you're completing the questions, it's important that you give answers that show how you feel. Questions at the beginning of the survey will explore your knowledge of wildlife. Questions toward the end of the survey will focus on your general feelings about wildlife and nature. Please be honest and answer all questions as best you can. All answers will be kept strictly confidential. All answers will be kept strictly confidential.

Notes and common questions:

If they ask you questions, try not to provide too much information. For knowledge questions, tell them to make their best guess. For attitude/opinion questions, tell them to best express how they feel.

If students do not feel comfortable answering a question, they do not have to answer it.
